Make sure that the device is in the main menu when connecting via bluetooth or USB.




When connecting a device for the first time, a passkey will be generated and displayed on the device screen. Enter this passkey on the phone prompt to complete the connection.


## Quick Start Guide

**WARNING: the barometer vent is NOT a reset button! Inserting objects into the vent hole may cause permanent damage to your device, and will void the warranty.**

## Quick Start



1. At the start of the day, go outside with a clear view of the sky.



2. Go to the GPS menu on the device and get a GPS signal.



3. If it cannot get a GPS signal within 5 minutes, turn the X2 off then try again.



4. Ready to jump! The device should be able to get a GPS signal more quickly for the next 4 hours.

## Removing arm mount strap

Use included pin or straightened paper clip to remove spring bars. Arm bands are standard 50mm/2 inch width elastic strap.
